The UCI Track World Championships for Masters makes a welcome return home to Manchester next year.

The three year deal will bring the world's best senior riders back to the City for the seven days of competition, to be held in October each year.

The popular events for both male and female riders aged 35 and over will feature up to 60 rainbow championships in Time Trial, Sprint, Pursuit, Points and Scratch events with a Super Saturday of exciting events added to the programme.

The championships will again be organised by the team that has kept Masters racing at the Manchester Velodrome since 1995 and has for the last three years organised the successful European event following the 12 years of world championships up to 2006.

The National Cycling Centre is currently undergoing major works to add an indoor BMX Centre to the site which will also improve the facilities available to the organisation.
